

bhi RoSH & WEEE Statements

WEEE (Waste Electrical & Electronic Equipment)

bhi is fully compliant to the Waste Electrical & Electronic Equipment (WEEE) Regulations 2006. We are a Member of the Compliance scheme (Scheme Approval Number WEE/MP3538PZ/SCH), which will handle our WEEE obligations on our behalf. Our Producer Registration Number is WEE/JJ0248QZ.

This EU legislation states that all producers who put products put on the market should have a "crossed out" wheelie bin symbol on the product, product packaging or product literature to denote membership of a compliance scheme. This marking indicates that products should not be disposed of with other household waste at the end of their working life. To prevent possible harm to the environment or human health from uncontrolled waste disposal, bhi products should be separated from other types of waste and recycled responsibly to promote the reuse of material resources. Mercury 0.1%
Hexavalent Chromium 0.1%
Polybrominated Biphenyls 0.1%
Polybrominated Diphenyl Ethers 0.1%
Cadmium 0.01%
